



LAUNDRY/HOUSEKEEPING ASSISTANT

The Chewonki Foundation is a year-round environmental education center located on a 400-acre peninsula in mid-coast Maine. During the summer, Chewonki offers a residential camp program for boys ages 8-15 and co-ed wilderness expeditions for 13-18 year olds. During the school year we offer an 11th grade semester school program, and Outdoor Classroom for School Groups.

Each summer, Camp Chewonki hires a group of enthusiastic, hard-working individuals to help support some of the most important aspects of running a safe, healthy and vital summer camp community. The duties of the Laundry/Housekeeping Assistant include washing and folding camp laundry, and general housekeeping duties such as washing windows, vacuuming and moping and cleaning bathroom facilities.

Supervision: The Laundry/Housekeeping assistants will be supervised by the housekeeping manager.

Essential Functions: Must be able to lift 25 pounds to table height.

Salary: \$7.50/hr minimum wage is the starting salary with increases for experience.

Dates: June 17 - August 12, 2010 with some opportunities to extend later into the summer.

Workday Structure: The day will begin at 8:00 am and will end at 2 pm. Lunch and a morning snack are included. The laundry room operates Monday- Saturday, but each worker will work five days a week, with some Saturdays included.
