Camp Chewonki for Girls

The Chewonki Foundation is a year-round environmental education center located on a 400-acre peninsula in mid-coast Maine with out lying facilities at Big Wood Pond in Jackman Maine, Big Eddy Campground on the West Branch of the Penobscot River, Fourth Debsconeag Wilderness Camps, and on several islands along the Maine Coast. Chewonki offers a summer wilderness camp for girls ages 8-16, a summer camp program for boys' ages 8-15, co-ed wilderness expeditions for 13-18 year olds, Family and Adult wilderness trips throughout the year, - an 11th grade program, the Maine Coast Semester, and environmental education programs for school groups. The Support Staff member will under the direction of the Senior Staff Team. Tasks may vary on a daily basis as the needs and priorities shift. The Support Staff position is primarily responsible for assisting the Food Coordinator in the kitchen to maintain a clean facility, assisting the Maintenance Coordinator with projects around camp, as well as assisting the Camp Director for daily camp life activities. Other tasks may include: food re-supplies for camp and trips, bringing laundry to town, assisting a group on a wilderness trip, and leading a camp activity.

Chewonki seeks someone who is enthusiastic about being a part of the Camp Chewonki for Girls community in the North Maine Woods; has experience working with children; and is able to work with a flexible, unpredictable schedule.

Who may apply: Applicants must be 18 years of age or older

Dates: June 8- Aug. 13, 2009, includes two week staff training

Requirements: Completed application, screening & interview. Current certification in Basic First Aid and CPR.

Health: Tobacco products are not allowed at Chewonki. A complete physical with current immunizations by a licensed physician is required 24 months prior to start of Camp.

Application Process: Submit your resume, cover letter, and *application to Genell Vashro, Girls Camp Director. *Applications can either be filled out online and submitted electronically, or you can download the application and send it in. Please visit our website: www.chewonki.org.
