



DISHWASHER/KITCHEN SUPPORT

The Chewonki Foundation is a year-round environmental education center located on a 400-acre peninsula in mid-coast Maine. During the summer, Chewonki offers a residential camp program for boys ages 8-15 and co-ed wilderness expeditions for 13-18 year olds. During the school year we offer an 11th grade semester school program, and Outdoor Classroom for School Groups.

Each summer, Camp Chewonki hires a group of 10 enthusiastic, hard-working individuals to help support some of the most important aspects of running a safe, healthy and vital summer camp community. The duties of the Dishwasher/Kitchen Helper include dish and pot washing, prep-cooking, kitchen and dining room set-up and cleaning, and general housekeeping in the kitchen area.

Supervision: This position will be supervised by the kitchen manager.

Essential Functions: Must be able to lift 25 pounds to table height.

Salary: \$7.50/hr minimum wage is the starting salary with increases for experience.

Dates: June 14 - August 11, with some opportunities to extend later in the summer.
