Agreement:

I enclose the deposit of \$100 for all Trips and Courses with a total tuition of \$200 or less. \$200 deposit for all Maine Trips and Courses with a tuition of More than \$200, \$400 for Canadian and all other trips outside of Maine. I understand that the remaining tuition is due 30 days prior to the start of the Trip /Course.

Tuition includes all boats, PFD's, group camping gear including tents, safety equipment, staff, all meals, charter flights, camping fees, food while on the trip, hotel accommodations and meals enroute where indicated. Not included in tuition, commercial airfare unless otherwise stated, personal clothing, fishing licensees, meals in hotels enroute where indicated. Participants are also responsible for any costs incurred for evacuation due to illness or injury. We recommend trip insurance.

Cancellation Policy: If I cancel within 30 days of the start of the trip I am responsible for the entire trip/course fee including deposit. 30-60 days full refund minus half of deposit, 60 days and over all deposit refunded minus \$25 processing fee. The Chewonki Foundation reserves the right to cancel any trip/course with a full refund in the event of unusual weather, water levels or other events beyond our control, or in the event that less than Chewonki's minimum number of participants enroll for a trip/course. In the event of low enrollment we may offer participants the option of paying a higher rate to take the trip/course.

Health: I understand that The Chewonki Foundation recommends that participants have a health examination by a licensed physician or nurse practitioner within the past year and that I must fill out and sign a medical history form.

Photo release: I hereby allow the Chewonki Foundation to use photographs or images of me/my child for appropriate promotional materials.

Assumption of Risk/Responsibility

I hereby acknowledge that this trip/program may take place in a wilderness or remote setting. There is risk inherent to travel by canoe, sailboat, and kayak or on foot in remote or wilderness settings. Each participant must have a basic level of involvement because of the nature of a wilderness trip/program. With this involvement comes the risk of physical injury that might not otherwise exist in normal living conditions. The demands of wilderness travel require that participants be in good physical health and be confident swimmers. In the event of injury or severe illness, medical facilities may be several hours or in some situations more than 24 hours away. Evacuation may include the use of airplane, helicopter, or boat, etc. Charges incurred as the result of an evacuation and medical expenses are the responsibility of the participant. The Chewonki Foundation cannot be held responsible for any inconvenience damage, or delay caused by late departure, weather, unusual water levels, strikes, itinerary changes, political or diplomatic changes, etc.

The Chewonki Foundation operates trips/programs on public and private lands, including but not limited to lands owned or managed by Katahdin Timberlands Company, The Nature Conservancy, Plum Creek, The State Of Maine, White Mountain National Forest, The United States Government, North Maine Woods Inc. and in Canada on lands owned by the Canadian Government, Province of Quebec, Province of Ontario and the Inuit Association of Nunavut, Cree Nation of Mistissini. I agree to indemnify, and hold harmless the above named agencies, companies, and organizations from and against any and all claims.

I understand that the wilderness trip in which I have enrolled is physically involving, and that I may encounter risks that I normally may not experience. I also agree to assume responsibility for my level of participation in the program's activities as has been described in the material that I have received from The Chewonki Foundation.
